## **Hencote Royale**

*Sloe gin, amaretto, rhubarb, Lemon*

*Full of strong flavours, this twist on a classic sour leaves an impression, combining the sweet notes of amoretto and sloe gin with citrus. Beware not to fall too head over heels for this drink.*

## **Cherry on Top**

*Amaretto, vodka, pineapple, cherry*

*As the name suggests, this sweet digestif takes the classic flavours of amoretto, vanilla, and pineapple and turns them into a perfect after-dessert drink.*

## **Pick of the Bunch**

*Gin, rhubarb, apple, vanilla, lemon*

## **Cosmopolitan**

Vodka, cranberry, lime

Dating back to 1936, the Cosmopolitan has changed over time before being refined at The Stand in South Beach, Miami. Its iconic blend of vodka, lime, and just enough cranberry to make it "pretty in pink" made it an instant classic.

## **Margarita**

Tequila, Orange, Lime

A Californian classic. Punchy and sour, the margarita blends tequila, orange liqueur, and lime to create a punchy and iconic drink. Shaken and served either straight up on the rocks

## **Negroni**

Gin, Campari, Vermouth

Originating from Florence in 1919, the Negroni is not for the faint of heart. Mixing gin, Rosso vermouth, and Campari, the Negroni perfectly balances bitterness with a subtle sweetness.

## **Picante**

Tequila, orange, lime, chilli

Created at Soho House, Los Angeles, the Picante quickly became a favourite. An evolution on the classic margarita, this chilli-infused drink has become a contemporary classic served globally.

## **Pornstar Martini**

Vodka, passionfruit, vanilla

Vanilla vodka, lime, passionfruit, topped with a sidecar of sparkling wine. The Pornstar martini has become an instant classing since emerging from London's 90's bar scene.

## **Singapore Sling**

Gin, benedictine, maraschino, Orange, pineapple, lime, grenadine

From the Raffles Hotel to the Skies. The Singapore sling has been a national staple of Singapore for over 100 years. A sweet, but not too sweet, drink that never fails to please.

## **Tokyo Tea**

Japanese melon, gin, rum, tequila, vodka, lime, lemon

Despite the name, the Tokyo tea boasts a classic with a Hollywood origin story. Created for the film Saturday Night Fever, this melon-flavoured spritzer isn't one to miss out on.

## **Whiskey Sour**

Bourbon, lemon, bitters

A nineteenth-century classic, the whiskey sour combines bourbon whiskey with just the right amount of sugar and lime to take the edge off; traditionally served with an egg white for its distinct velvety texture.

## **Ochazuke**
